Welcome back to our Synod Corner! Last October, the Diocesan Synod Committee created the Synod Corner to provide news about the Synodal journey in the Diocese of Stockton and the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops that took place in Rome during the month of October 2024.

The General Assembly concluded on October 27, 2024, with the publication of the **Final Document for a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission**. In the letter that accompanies this document, Pope Francis offers several statements that are important to all of us as we continue this Synodal journey:

□ Acknowledging the value of the synodal journey completed, I now hand over to the whole Church the indications contained in the Final Document, as a restitution of what has matured during these years, through listening and discernment, and as an authoritative guide for her life and mission. □

The **Final Document** will form part of the ordinary Magisterium of the Successor of Peter and as such I ask that it be accepted. The local Churches and Church groups are now required to implement, in various contexts, the authoritative indications contained in the Document, through processes of discernment and decision-making envisaged by law and by the Document itself.

□ The conclusion of the 16th Ordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops does not put an end to the synodal process.

The Final Document can be found on the diocesan website <https://www.stocktondiocese.org/synod2021-2023>. We suggest that a reading of the Introduction (pages 3 - 6) will assist in understanding what is contained in the **Final Document** and how to continue the Synodal journey.

Future Synod Corners will be published several times a month with specific sections to read and how your recommendations are supported by the **Final Document** and the Diocese.

May the Holy Spirit, gift of the Risen One, sustain and guide the entire Church in this journey.
